EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The Education Committee plans and provides enriching classes, seminars and conferences for CSCSW members and the professional community. This is often done in collaboration with other organizations in the community, for example University of Denver Graduate School of Social Work, the Denver Psychoanalytic Society, and NASW. Since 2002 this committee has sponsored a Salon Series, informal gatherings where members present interesting educational topics.

MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

The Membership Committee performs the vital function of ensuring the continuity of the organization. The tasks of this committee are primarily twofold: marketing CSCSW to clinical social workers in Colorado in order to increase membership; and providing a structure for the inclusion and integration of clinical social workers new to the community or to the profession. We are constantly looking for ways to be seen as a useful resource to clinical social workers throughout the state. To that end, this committee focuses on the services that CSCSW can offer to its members. The Membership Committee is also concerned with helping new members feel part of the clinical social work community. It provides mentoring groups to recently graduated MSW's, led by a "seasoned" clinician. Other services have been provided to the students at the University of Denver Graduate School of Social Work with the dual goal of helping them integrate into the professional community and attracting them to membership in CSCSW.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE

The Legislative Committee follows and reports to the members on relevant federal and state bills and policies of concern to clinical social workers and their clientele. Additionally we develop needed legislation or positions as an individual organization or in coalitions with other groups. In past years, this committee has been very active in protecting the licensure and vendorship of clinical social workers. It has also coordinated the participation of CSCSW members in key task forces with other professional disciplines in the state of Colorado. One or more members of this committee participate in a joint legislative committee with NASW, which hires and oversees a lobbyist to represent our common concerns in the state legislature.

PRACTICE STANDARDS COMMITTEE

The Practice Standards Committees of CSCSW and NASW have been an actively combined working committee since 1992. The Joined Committee is charged with the task of creating guidelines and standards for social work practice. This is a dynamic committee which has provided leadership to the licensing sunset coalition on social work issues. In addition, it has developed guidelines on issues such as dual role relationships, termination, working with children and their families, disclosures, informed consent, termination, ethical dilemmas in third party situations, supervision, and use of the electronic media. Practice Standards manuals and materials for HIPAA compliance are available through this committee.

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL COMMITTEE

The charge of this committee is to provide avenues for dissemination of information both within CSCSW and to the community at large. Their responsibilities include 1) maintenance of our website; 2) development and maintenance of a fair and equitable system to link CSCSW members with potential client referrals; and 3) response to the CSCSW telephone line. In addition, they may perform other public relations functions as needed.

Awards and Scholarships Committee

The Awards and Scholarships Committee was initiated in 2005. It is charged with developing guidelines for the two sets of awards and one scholarship that will be given annually by CSCSW. CSCSW has for the past several years given awards of two types. One set of awards is given annually to members who have been nominated for recognition of exemplary service to the organization or exemplary clinical work. The other award (the Ina Mae Denham Award) is given each spring to a University of Denver Graduate School of Social Work graduating MSW student who has written a high quality paper on a clinical subject. The Awards and Scholarships Committee is also responsible for the process of awarding the CSCSW \$1,000 scholarship every year to a University of Denver MSW student who is beginning the second year of study as a specialist in clinical training.

NEWSLETTER

"*The Clinician*" is the newsletter for the CSCSW. Published quarterly, the newsletter is the primary medium by which members are kept informed and up to date on the business and events of the CSCSW.
